*Meetings are available for those who have shown a legitimate approach to the process and are active in the monthly seminars.

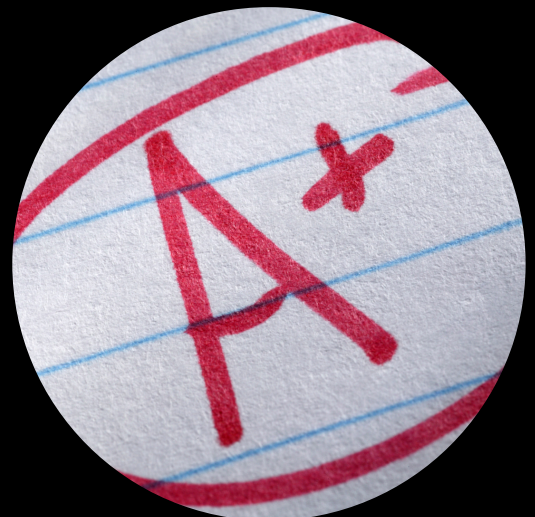


ID Camps / Showcase Prep
